

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING BY THE GLASS

Edouard Brun & Cie Reserve 1er Cru – Aÿ, Champagne France

Excellent Grower Champagne from a small producer not often seen in the UK. From Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, and aged in bottle for minimum of 2 years giving it richer more biscuity flavours, along with aromas of bruised red apple and a creamy fine mousse. £11 (125ml)

Wiston Estate Cuvee Brut NV - Sussex, England

A fantastic English Sparkling Wine made in the South Downs by one of the UK's best wine makers. Made using the traditional Champagne method with equal parts Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier for a complex, toasty fizz with crisp green apple and bready flavours. £10 (125ml)

Armance B Brut- Loire, France

Made from 60% Chardonnay and 40% Folle Blanche grapes for a fine, and elegant bouquet of freshly made bread, lemon zest, ginger and dried herbs. Very dry, delicate, and vibrant. £8 (125ml)

HALF BOTTLE CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

Taittinger Brut Reserve NV – Reims, Champagne, France

Light and elegant bubbles from the 'best of the best' grape growers in the area. Vivacious, lively aromas of youthful peach, vanilla, apple and honey notes. The perfect toast, everytime! £35 (375 ml)

Sparkling Vouvray NV, Marc Bredif - Loire Valley, France

Supple effervescence and notable for its creamy mouthfeel, offering gentle jasmine, quince, and pear aromas. Enjoy as an aperitif or as a fine compliment to many dishes. £24 (375 ml)

La Jara 'Baby' Frizzante Bianco – Orvieto, Italy

Semi-sparkling, light in alcohol and wonderfully fresh. With a light apple and raspberry flavour. The wine combines the delicacy of its scents with the freshness of the taste, intensified by the bubbles. £15 (375 ml)

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING BY THE BOTTLE

Bollinger ‘La Grande Année Brut’ 2004 – Champagne, France

Only produced in exceptional years, this is the top expression of Bollinger’s house style. Rich biscuity aromas mingle with notes of exotic spices, rhubarb, and stone fruit. A truly remarkable Champagne. £110

Laurent Perrier NV Cuvée Rosé - Champagne, France

Famous for its highly expressive bouquet thanks to the extended maceration of 100% Pinot Noir grapes. Clean and wonderfully fresh, with prominent flavours of soft red berry and black cherry fruits. £85

Bollinger ‘Special Cuvée’ NV - Champagne, France

A subtle combination of structure, length, and complexity. Very fine and vivacious bubbles showing beautiful aromatics of roasted apples, peaches, pear and brioche £65

Laurent Perrier NV Brut - Champagne, France

Delicate yet complex, fresh and well-balanced with hints of citrus and white fruits. Pale gold in colour with a steady flow of fine and persistent bubbles. £55

Eduard Bruin Premier Cru - Aÿ, Champagne, France

Excellent Grower Champagne from a small producer not often seen in the UK. From Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, and aged in bottle for minimum 2 years giving it richer more biscuity flavours, along with aromas of bruised red apple and a creamy fine mousse. £52

Wiston Estate Cuvee Brut - Sussex, England

A fantastic English Sparkling Wine made in the South Downs by one of the UK's best wine makers. Made using the traditional Champagne method with equal parts Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier for a complex, toasty fizz with crisp green apple and bready flavours. £50

Champagne Piillot, ‘Cuvée de Reserve’, Père & Fils – Champagne, France

A light golden yellow colour with a delicate bead of bubbles. This Champagne has a mature, floral nose of hawthorn fruit and notes of cherry plums. It is straightforward and fresh in the mouth, it is really silky smooth. The full richness of the Pinot Noir shows through beautifully. Full and well balanced with a good length. £48

Armance B Brut- Loire, France

Made from 60% Chardonnay and 40% Folle Blanche grapes for a fine, and elegant bouquet of freshly made bread, lemon zest, ginger and dried herbs. Very dry, delicate, and vibrant. £35

Pinot Grigio Rosé Spumante, La Jara – Orvieto, Italy

Delightfully soft semi-sparkling rose showing fresh scents of rose grapefruit, raspberries, wild strawberries and sherbet. Elegant and refined. £32

ROSÉ WINE BY THE GLASS

Rioja Rosado Pálido – Rioja

Delectably pink in colour, leading to a beautifully refined florality and fruitiness on the nose. Good structure and balanced flavours give this rosé a delightfully fresh, clean finish. £6.20 (175 ml) £8.10 (250 ml)

ROSÉ WINE BY THE BOTTLE

Rioja Rosado Pálido – Rioja

Delectably pink in colour, leading to a beautifully refined florality and fruitiness on the nose. Good structure and balanced flavours give this rosé a delightfully fresh, clean finish. £24

Sancerre Rosé, Christian Dauny 2014 – France

An elegant pale pink rosé made from 100% Pinot Noir grapes that is full of elegance and finesse. It is light and refreshing yet has extraordinary depths to enjoy and entice. £35

DESSERT WINES

Elysium Black Muscat, Quady 2014– California

Made from a rarely seen Red Muscat variety. An expressive bouquet of cherry, strawberry and rose petals along with a rich velvety finish. £6.70 glass (100ml) £24 bottle (375 ml)

Essensia Orange Muscat, Quady 2014 – California

Vibrant orange in colour, delivering bittersweet orange marmalade, apricot and spice. Rich and sweet balanced perfectly by a fine fruity acidity. £6.70 glass (100ml) £24 bottle (375 ml)

Vat 5 Botrytis Semillon, Deen De Bortoli 2009 – Australia

Gorgeous nose of orange blossom and honey, full of unctuous tropical fruit flavours balanced with refreshing acidity. £6.95 glass (100ml) £25 bottle (375 ml)

Château de Suduiraut Sauternes 2008 – France

1st classed growth Sauternes. This elegantly rich wine shows orange peel and mineral notes on the nose. The palate is full bodied with almonds, spice, honey and crystallised fruits through to a lovely, lingering finish. £35 bottle (375 ml)

Pedro Ximenez Viejo Napoleon Hidalgo - Spain

Rich and full-bodied, with abundant aromas and flavours of prunes, raisins, figs, roasted nuts, and exotic spices. Sweet, smooth and luscious on the palate. £6.70 (100ml glass) £38 bottle (500ml)

Brachetto Piemonte, Castello del Poggio, Dolce Spumante - Piemonte Italy

A lovely pink sweet sparkling wine with an elegant aroma and subtle fragrances of fresh roses, with hints of peach, raspberry and a mousse of strawberries and peaches with black pepper counterpoints. £6.50 (125ml glass) £30bottle(750ml)
