Mauzac Sauvignon, Vigné-Lourac 2014 – Vin de Pays, France

Incredibly fragrant and fresh, delivering crisp aromas of green apple and pear, with hints of gooseberry and elderflower.

Viognier, Vina Edmara 2015 - Central Valley, Chile

Full of life and intensity, with notes of ripe fleshy apricots, pineapple, peaches and hints of citrus flower. The palate is full flavoured and luscious leading to a refreshing finish.

Muscadet ‘Sur Lie’ Les Gautronnieres, Domaine Bonnet-Hateau 2014 – Loire, France

Pinot Gris ‘Tradition’, Bott Frères 2013 - Alsace, France (375 ml)

Classic 'Old World' freshness brings to mind aromas of apricots, baked apples, and forest breezes, with a well-balanced and off-dry finish.

Sancerre ‘Thauvenay’, Domaine Masson Blondlet 2012 - Loire Valley, France (375 ml)

Enhanced texture and youthful characteristics of citrus and honeysuckle, but with a minerality on the palate providing a pure and balanced structure.

Sauvignon Blanc, Astrolabe 2014 - Marlborough, New Zealand (375 ml)

Expressive aromas that exude lime peel, elderflower, currant leaf, with a fresh purity of citrus and gooseberry flavours. Excellent example of pure Sauvignon Blanc from N.Z.

Mauzac Sauvignon, Vigné-Lourac 2014 – Vin de Pays, France

Incredibly fragrant and fresh, delivering crisp aromas of green apple and pear with hints of gooseberry and elderflower. These lively aromas carry through to the palate, complimented by a zesty citrus finish.

Viognier, Vina Edmara 2015 - Central Valley, Chile

Full of life and intensity, with notes of ripe fleshy apricots, pineapple, peaches and hints of citrus flower. The palate is full flavoured and luscious with a crisp, refreshing finish.

Domain Cavalier Blanc, Château Lascaux 2014 - Languedoc-Roussillon, France

A delightful blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Viognier, Marsanne & Roussanne. Aromas of ripe peaches, melon and citrus are beautifully enhanced by pure fruit flavours and bright dry backbone.

Muscadet “Sur Lie” Les Gautronnieres’, Domaine Bonnet-Hateau 2014 – Loire Valley, France

Expressive bone-dry white that is all about the freshness. Lifting aromas of citrus blossom, lemon zest, and a zesty acidity to match, leaving you reminiscent of eating freshly picked grapes on a vineyard near the sea.

Chenin Blanc 'La Cotte Mill', Franschhoek Cellar 2015 – Western Cape, South Africa

With full flavours and ripe concentration, this beauty offers a fuller body with tropical fruit, nectarine, and honeysuckle aromas, leading to a dense mouthfeel and a zesty freshness that dances on your palate.

Macabeo, Paralleda, Xarelo-lo 'Blanc de Pacs', Pares Balta 2013 – Penedès, Spain

Difficult to pronounce, but a pleasure to drink! A pure, unoaked white made from a blend of traditional Spanish grape varieties displaying intense aromas of freshly-picked pear and green apple and a zippy fruity finish.

Piqpoul de Pinet 'L'Enfant Terrible’, Domaine la Grangette 2014 – Languedoc-Roussillon, France

If the sunny vineyards of Southern France could be bottled, they would be found in this wonderful wine. Refreshing and bone-dry, with a delicate nose of floral, citrus, and steel flint along with a lemony freshness that dazzles the tastebuds.

Gavi di Gavi, Cascina Del Melo 2014 – Piedmont, Italy

Come to be known as "Italy's answer to Chablis" thanks to its lively aromas and steely minerality. Completely unoaked for the purest expression, giving intense aromas of green apple and almonds, and a twist of lemon zest on the finish.

Chardonnay, Bodega Sottano 2014 - Mendoza, Argentina

A clean unoaked expression of ripe grapes at harvest time, bursting with honeydew melon, pineapple, mango and citrus aromas and flavours. Excellent body and texture in the mouth with nice refreshing acidity.

Viognier , Château De Campuget 1753 2013 – Rhone Valley, France

A beautiful bouquet of lip-smacking juicy peaches, apricot, and honeysuckle. The palate offers an intensely focused and structured mouthfeel, leading to a lengthy polished finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Saint Clair 2015 - Marlborough, New Zealand

An initial burst of passionfruit, gooseberry and lime with underlying tones of currant leaf and fresh grass, then further intensified on the palate with a racing acidity and a fresh finish.

Côtes Du Rhône Blanc 'La Becassone', Domaine André Brunel 2011- Rhone Valley, France

A classic Southern Rhone white blend of Roussanne, Grenache Blanc, Clairette with emphasis on comforting flavours with plenty of depth. Ripe stone fruits and orange blossoms complimented by sweet spice notes and a creamy mouthfeel. Perfect for hearty winter dishes.

Pinot Blanc ‘Katz’, Clement Klur 2011 – Alsace, France

Classy and refined, with aromatics of orange blossom, apricot, melon with a slightly smoky undertone. The delicate flavors and round, weighty mouthfeel makes for a fantastic match for your meal from beginning to end.

Sancerre, Domaine Gerard Millet 2014 - Loire Valley, France

The epitome of Sancerrois elegance, with a delicate mineral scented nose, and beautifully rich yet subtle flavours. Expressive nose intermixing notes of grapefruit, boxwood and mineral undercurrents.

Pouilly-Fume ‘Pascal Kerbiquet’, Domaine du Bouchot 2014 – Loire Valley, France

Deeper and more structured than its Loire counterpart, but equally amazing and intriguing. Vibrant aromas of gooseberry, grapefruit, and acacia flowers which are then accentuated by a smoky, flinty, gunpowdery nose. Pure luxury in a bottle.

Chablis 1er Cru 'Montmains', Domaine Jean Goulley 2011 - Chablis, France

An excellent example of expressive, unoaked white from this classic Old World region. Youthful and pure, with the vivacity of citrus fruit, pronounced mineral character, and a long, consistent finish.

Roter Veltliner ‘Reisenthal’, Mantlerhof 2012– Kremstal, Austria

There aren't many moments when a white wine can surprise and seduce you..but this will be one of them. From a rare Red-skinned white grape variety found only in Austria and only made by a handful of producers. Slightly off-dry with elegantly extracted flavours of sweet lemon, red and green apples and a mouthwatering mineral finish

Chateauf-neuf-du-Pape Blanc, Domaine de la Solitude 2013 - Rhone Valley, France

If you have not yet experienced the pleasure of a white wine from this famous French region, you are in for a treat! History and tradition meets modern winemaking to produce beautifully expressive flavours of ripe citrus, honey, and savoury herbs.

Chassagne-Montrachet, Domaine René Monnier 2013 - Burgundy, France

From a family committed to traditional vineyard treatments and organic practices. Stylish and elegant, boasting notes of toasted almond, ripened apple and honey, with a nicely integrated soft oak touch. Plenty of weight on the palate with fleshy, lemony acidity and a round, smooth finish.

Chardonnay 'Estate Bottled', Far Niente 2013 – Napa Valley, USA

Earning its reputation as one of the Great White Wines of California, this is a wonderfully vibrant Chardonnay bursting aromas of bright lemon-lime zest, honeydew melon, and peaches, with beautiful structure and a delectably creamy aftertaste.
