Merlot Syrah, Le Montalus Rouge 2014 – Pay d’Oc, France

A versatile red, with expressive red berry aromas intertwined with floral and sweet licorice notes £5.70 (175 ml) £7.40 (250 ml)

Negroamaro 'Il Pumo', Salento San Marzano 2013 – Puglia, Italy

Ripe red berry and sweet plummy fruit aromas followed by hints of spices and coffee. Well-structured and equally intense on the palate with a slightly savory finish. £6.10 (175 ml) £8.00 (250 ml)

Pinot Noir Reserva, Carmen 2014 - Leyda Valley, Chile

Malbec, Domaine Jean Bousquet 2013 - Mendoza, Argentina

Beyond robust and rampant. Bursting with blackberry fruit, black plums, and black pepper, all enhanced by a slight touch of oak.

Madiran 'Cuvee Charles de Batz', Domaine Berthoumieu 2011 - Gascony, France

Made from Tannat grapes with a touch of Cabernet, giving this hearty red notes of ripe red and dark fruits, cedary oak, and tannins that pair best with intensely flavoured dishes.

Shiraz 'Lionheart of the Barossa', Dandelion Vineyards 2012 - Southern Australia

A lighter, more jovial style with firm but fine tannins, and expresses luscious hedgerow and bramble fruits, with an under-currant of warm, rich Christmas spices and cocoa.

Pinot Noir Reserva, Carmen 2014 - Leyda Valley, Chile

Beautifully balanced and reminiscent of a more elegant 'Old World' style. Intense black cherry, wild berry, and dried herb aromas are complimented by a delicate and savoury palate. An exceptional wine that will compliment almost any dish.

Negroamaro 'Il Pumo', Salento San Marzano 2013 – Puglia, Italy

Ripe red berry and sweet plummy fruit aromas burst from the glass, followed by hints of spices and coffee. Well structured and equally ripe and intense on the palate, with a velvety smooth and slightly savoury finish.

The Black Shiraz, Berton Vineyards 2014 – South East Australia

Deliciously dark berry fruits with black pepper and cocoa powder undertones, with a muscular structure and fine tannins, with a lengthy finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva, Perez Cruz 2013 - Maipo Valley, Chile

Vibrant, rich, and nothing short of excellent! Aromatic fruit expression, bursting with ripe berries, blackcurrant, huckleberry, and a touch of eucalyptus. Velvety smooth tannins and sweet oak flavours complete the package.

Rioja Crianza 'Majister Bibendi', Navarrsotillo 2012 – La Rioja, Spain

Gently oak aged, allowing for the pure expression of Tempranillo to shine through. Perfectly balanced between fruity and powerful. with loads of juicy cherry and wild strawberry aromas, and a touch of soft vanilla and cinnamon spice.

Chianti Superiore DOCG, Majnoni Guicciardini 2013 - Tuscany, Italy

Forget everything you thought you knew, and trust that this is the true essence of what Chianti should be. A mouthwatering juicy expression full of tart cherry, sweet plum and slight earthy tones, with elegantly balanced tannins and a finish that doesn't quit.

Pinot Noir, Saint Clair 2014 – Marlborough, New Zealand

Luscious layers of wild raspberries, red and black cherries, sweet spice and fresh coffee. A lean acidity compliments the ripe fruit flavours on the palate and leaves your tastebuds yearning for another sip.

Pic Saint Loup, Château de Lascaux 2014 – Languedoc-Roussillon, France

A true hidden gem filled with intensity and finesse. A blend of Syrah and Grenache gives the wine deep colour and concentration. Rich red fruits with a spicy, earthy, meaty complexity that is unique and utterly delicious.

Morgon 'Vielles Vignes', Domaine de la Bonne Tonne 2012 – Beaujolais, France

Red strawberries, dried fig, and violet aromas with slight dried herb and pepper notes. A delightfully balanced palate delivers a purity of flavours unique to this extremely approachable medium-light bodied style.

Crozes-Hermitage 'Cuvée Terra d'Eclat', Domain de la Ville Rouge 2012 – Rhone, France

Remarkably gorgeous Syrah from a small organic producer in the Northern Rhone. Intense aromas of red fruits, black olives, and cracked pepper. A refined palate, with deep concentration and silky texture.

Malbec, Quinto Riglos 2013 - Uco Valley, Argentina

Rich and highly aromatic, with a lovely bouquet of perfumed blackberry, floral violet, and a hint of pepper. Spice, plum and herbal flavours carry through the palate, and along with a soft mouthfeel, leave a beautifully soft and lasting finish.

Saint-Émilion Grand Cru Classe, Château Fleur de Lisse 2010 - Bordeaux, France

Blessed with a balance between elegance and complexity. Smooth and rich, with notes of plush black plums, cedar wood and spice., and exquisitely fine tannins lending to a long memorable finish.

Margaux 'Cru Artisan', Chateau des Graviers 2012 - Bordeaux, France

Farmed biodynamically from a producer who takes utmost care of his land and vines. A classic Claret offering superbly ripe cassis fruit, blackcurrant leaf and violet. Supple, silky tannins with a lively and elegant structure. Once tried, never forgotten.

Barolo, Erbaluna 2011 – Piedmont, Italy

Known as the 'king of wine, and the wine of kings'. A serious wine made from the high acid, highly tannic Nebbiolo grape. Expect aromas of violets, ripe cherries, tar, and truffles, and an unforgettable experience in luxury.

Chateaufort-du-Pape 'Reserve', Château Fortia 2010 – Rhone Valley, France

From one of the oldest estates in the Rhone Valley, with roots deep in tradition, and a terrior said to be 'magical' for Syrah. Intense black fruit characters shine through along with a savoury and smokey backbone, and hints of prune and violets.

Nuits-Saint-Georges 'Vielles Vignes', Domain Chicotot 2012 - Burgundy, France

A truly elegant wine with a voluptuous perfume and robust intensity. The fullest, deepest expression that Burgundian terrior offers with plenty of plummy richness and fresh strawberry fruit along with a beautiful round structure on the palate.

Gevey-Chambertin 'Les Marchais', Domaine Pierre Naigeon 2011 - France

Made from grapes grown on vines averaging an age of 50+ years, giving this wine fantastic depth and concentration. Expressive, fragrant aromas revealing juicy red cherry, dark plum, and a slightly earthy structure, with hints of licorice and spice.
